Description of the project

- COVID 19 management and readiness in Base Hospital Muthur has been developed based on the guidelines and instructions provided by the Ministry of Health and Indigenous Medical services
- Formed Operational cell

Out Patient Department & Clinic

- Triage area 1
- Triage area 2
- Other Area 3
- Hand washing facilities to staff & Patients
- Displayed billboard in 2 languages
- Maintain social distance for patients



Isolation ward & Respiratory unit for COVID 19 suspected patients

- 4 beds unit with 3 zones
- One bed for emergency treatment care
- Established separate respiratory units in Paediatric, male and female Medical wards
- Isolation maternity unit & operation theatre



Provision of other Healthcare services

- Routine services have been provided without any interruption– Medical, Pediatric, Surgical and Obstetric care and for critically ill patients
- All OPD and clinic have been conducted
- Drugs have been issued to the clinic patients at their door site during curfew

Medical equipment and PPE

- Hospital made PPE
- PPE supply from RDHS office
- Maintain separate register & stock maintenance

Overall Infection control

- Responsibility of ICNO
- Regular usage of chlorine with the recommended percentage and alcohol for disinfection
- Separate check list maintained

Other Activities for the preparedness

- Introduced hotlines for public access
- Education & Training for staff on COVID 19 prevention & control
